






Z THYROID ANTIBODY This blood test measures thyroid antibody levels to see if an autoimmune disorder is impacting thyroid function.





4 THYROID SCAN This test uses dye and a special camera to look at the size, shape and function of the thyroid. It can identify overactive thyroid.

HORMONE LEVEL This blood test measures thyroid hormone levels. The results can indicate over- or underactive thyroid.

This scan uses sound waves to make pictures of your thyroid. This is used to look for lumps that may be cancerous.
